



# Grant Review Workgroup Recommendations for 2015 AmeriCorps Competitive Funding

Compliant proposals were submitted from the Montana Conservation Corps, FoodCorps, Montana Campus Compact and Domestic Preparedness Assistance Center. The Montana Legal Services Association and Montana State Parks submitted their request for year two continuation funding. Total funding requests for the 2015-2016 grant year are just over \$3 million.
