2013 Youth Serve Montana Scholarship Distribution Process

The 2013 Youth Serve Montana Scholarship has been made possible through support from the Governor's Office of Community Service; Montana Campus Compact and their member institutions; and Student Assistance Foundation. Eighty-four Montana students received a \$1,000 scholarship to attend a Montana Campus Compact member institution.

- The Governor's Office of Community Service will notify the Montana Campus Compact Institutions of the 2013 scholarship recipients and funds will be sent directly to the college or university that was indicated in the student's scholarship application.
- Students must notify the Governor's Office of Community Service if he or she plans to attend a different campus by August 1, 2013. Please email, mail, or fax a letter declaring the change of school to:

- After August 1, if the student chooses to attend or transfer to a different school, he or she will need to contact both the new and previous financial aid officers and the Governor's Office of Community Service. The student will only be able to transfer the scholarship to a Montana Campus Compact member institution.
- The Governor's Office of Community Service will send \$500 for each student at the campuses after verifying enrollment in the fall. This should happen in October.
- The campuses will match the \$500 payment for a total scholarship of \$1,000. Questions about the match payment should be directed to the school's Office of the President or Montana Campus Compact.
- The financial aid officer may choose to apply the scholarship across two semesters of the 2013-2014 academic year. For further questions about how the scholarship is applied, please contact the institution's financial aid office.
