



The Governor's Office of Community Service (AKA OCS & ServeMontana) promotes and expands national service and volunteer opportunities in Montana. OCS administers federal funding to AmeriCorps State programs in Montana, provides support to organizations, and encourages citizens of all ages and backgrounds to engage in service

AmeriCorps

AmeriCorps is a program of the Corporation for National and Community Service (CNCS), an independent federal agency whose mission is to improve lives, strengthen communities, and foster civic engagement through service and volunteering. AmeriCorps consists of three programs: AmeriCorps State & National, AmeriCorps VISTA, and AmeriCorps National Civilian Community Corps (NCCC).

OCS oversees 6 AmeriCorps State programs in Montana that collectively mobilize over 500 members into service each year: Big Sky Watershed Corps, Community in Action Corps, Justice for Montanans Project, Montana Campus Compact, Montana Conservation Corps, and Montana State Parks AmeriCorps. serve.mt.gov/americorps-in-montana/

ServeMontana Symposium

The ServeMontana Symposium is our signature annual event. Each March, coinciding with AmeriCorps Week, this event brings together hundreds of AmeriCorps members serving in Montana to further opportunities for service, learning, and collaboration. Each year, a unique theme is chosen with corresponding sessions, speakers, and panels, along with a service project. serve.mt.gov/ServeMT/servemontana-symposium

State Service Plan

The State Service Plan is a three-year framework for national service and community volunteerism in Montana. The plan is required by the Corporation for National and Community Service (CNCS) and under Montana law. It determines strategic goals and initiatives of the Montana Commission on Community Service. The Youth Serve Montana scholarship promotes volunteerism, encourages young leaders to further their education, and provides tuition assistance to Montana students attending college in-state. Each year, 100 Montana high school seniors receive the \$1K Youth Serve Montana Scholarship for outstanding service contributions. Applications open in the fall/early winter. Scholarships are awarded in the spring. serve-montana-scholarships.
