On March 12-14, 2025, nearly 150 AmeriCorps State, National, VISTA, and NCCC members serving across Montana will gather for the 16th annual ServeMontana Symposium at Carroll College in Helena, MT. AmeriCorps engages committed citizens to meet essential community needs while developing lifelong skills.

Hosted by the Governor's Office of Community Service, this multiday conference-style event focuses on providing training and resources for AmeriCorps members and program staff. The 2025 theme, *Elements of Service*, emphasizes that the internal forces that drive AmeriCorps members - hope, dedication, grit, and care; are as unique, powerful, and intertwined as the forces that shape the Montana landscapes we hold dear. Members will guide their peers through regional networking sessions, attend breakout sessions and keynote presentations with topics as diverse as the communities across the Big Sky state, complete a service project together, participate in an all-attendee civic reflection, and more!
